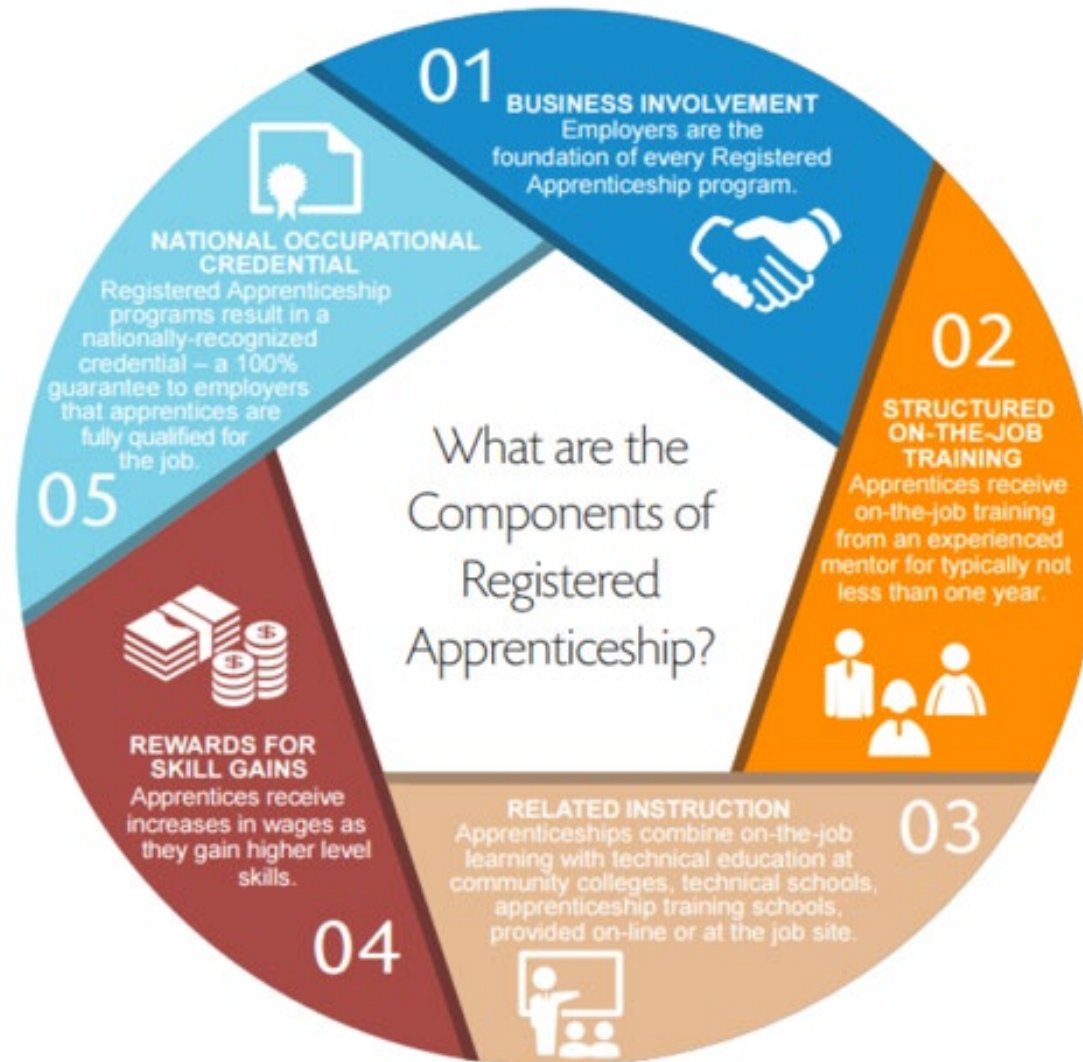

WHY APPRENTICESHIP?

- Design state-of-the-art OJT and RSI focused on fostering strong relationships with children and families, and producing optimal child outcomes
 - Acknowledge the fluid nature of these career ladders and pathways – wherever careers lead, apprentices and employers benefit from the training and skills developed in apprenticeships
 - Increase the preparedness of the workforce while ensuring pay raises and competitive wages
 - Focus on “high hanging fruit” – those with the most to gain from apprenticeship opportunities who are often deemed ineligible or uninterested
 - Apprenticeships are mentioned three times in the Governor’s Master Plan for Early Learning and Care in the section on Support Children’s Learning and Development by Enhancing Educator Competencies, Incentivizing and Funding Career Pathways, and Implementing Supportive Program Standards.
